WebWorking with Molecular Genetics Part Two: ANSWERS per min \times 40 min = 2.4×10^6 bp. Dividing the size of the chromosome by this amount synthesized per fork gives 4.64×10^6 bp / 2.4×10^6 bp, or 1.93. Hence two replication forks are sufficient. For bidirectional replication, this requires only one origin, and indeed this is the case.
